

## Q: What can feedback do for a writer?

*Hint: look at the example below!*

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### ROUGH DRAFT

### FEEDBACK

The internet is dangerous **because** we can know where you are and your privacy with **the** internet. This is a serious **problem**. / This causes serious trouble. Because someone can know your information. ~~Now, many~~ Many people in the **world are using the internet now**, and it can connect with ~~the world~~ people with mobile **phones**.

### FINAL DRAFT

Many people in the world are using the internet, and there are many different ways to connect to it. For example, people all over the world can use the internet with mobile phones. However, your location and your privacy can be shared easily. This is a serious problem because anyone can know your information. For this reason, the internet can be dangerous.

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A: Feedback helped this writer to...

- 1) Reorganize the ideas so that they lead to the main point.
- 2) Clarify causes and effects (*internet use on mobile phones causes users' location to be known*).
- 3) Connect sentences using words like *because*.
- 4) Get rid of unnecessary words like *we* and *the world*.
- 5) Choose more natural expressions.
  - × *is a serious trouble*
  - *is a serious problem*
  - *causes serious trouble*

Writing involves lots of rewriting. Feedback can be helpful at any point in this process!
